## RE Signs and Symbols

The children will be learning about the Sacrament of Baptism. They will learn about the signs and symbols used in this Sacrament, and the special words said by the priest, parents and Godparents.

## English, PSHE, History and Geography

## Mathematics

We have been adding Tens and Ones to another 2 digit number. We have been focussing on the accuracy of recording this information on an Abacus. We have introduced the concept of Partitioning a number so for example 23 is partitioned into 2 Tens and 3 Ones. We will continue to apply this to problem solving. We will also look at sequencing of numbers on a number line and counting in steps for example $2,4,6,8 \quad 5,10,15 \quad 80,70,60$
Home learning: Please could you focus on counting from 1 to 100 and ensure that the children can do this mentally and are pronouncing the numbers correctly. Perhaps try counting from 100 to 0 .
