Spellings - 'es' these two letters carry meaning when at the end of a word that was singular to make it a plural word. An example of this is **box** is singular and **boxes** is plural.

Home learning: Comprehension sheet. Well done all of you for completing these sheets which aid reading and understanding.

Maths: We have given the children an activity on adding by first making a number bond to 10. This will aid their mental Maths so for example if adding:

13 + 17 = We would add 3 + 7 = 10 Then add 10 + 10 = 20 Finally 10 + 20 = 30

RE: We will be learning about another world religion, Judaism and one aspect of it which is Shabbat. The children will learn about this celebration that occurs in Jewish families every Friday and ending on Saturday at sundown.

English and Topic: Special People
