At Home: Ask your child to bring you two items. See if they can tell you which one is taller or shorter.



The children have been enjoying their learning activities in nursery this week. We have been learning about birthdays and having our own 'Birthday party.'





At Home: Ask your child to bring you two items. See if they can tell you which one is bigger or smaller.



The children have been having fun in Nursery this week. We have been learning about Advent and making an Advent wreath for Nursery for when Advent starts next week.








Literacy
