

We will be beginning our new topic Birthdays. The children will be talking about their memories of different birthdays they have been to. The children will be creating their own birthday party in the classroom.



In Literacy the children will be introduced to a new book, 'We're going to find the Monster' by Malorie Blackman. This is a lovely text all about a brother and sister who go on an adventure to find a monster! It has an exciting twist at the end. We will be creating our own text map of the story and rehearsing it. By the end of the week your child should be able to tell you the whole story!



The children will be learning three new sounds this week, z, qu, ch. We will be using the phrase 'diagraph, two letters one sound'. Hopefully they will tell you this at home! The new tricky words we will be learning are go, no, to, and into. In Maths the children will be learning to identify and understand the quantity of 4 and 5. Match the quantity to the numerical number and subitise (be able to tell you how many without counting) numbers up to 5. We will see what happens when we add one more or take one away from the numbers within 5. We will explore this practically playing a range of games indoors and outdoors.

We will be continuing with our topic Birthdays. This week the children will be thinking about Advent; a time for getting ready. They will think about how they get ready for different activities for example a picnic, school, swimming and then we talk more about how we can get ourselves ready.



In Literacy we will continue with our text 'We're Going to find the Monster.' The children will continue to rehearse the text everyday as speaking is so important in order to develop good writers. We will also be focussing on the monster. The children will be designing their own monster and labelling its features.



The children will be learning four new sounds this week, sh, th, ng, nk. We will be using the phrase 'diagraph, two letters one sound'. Hopefully they will tell you this at home! The new tricky words we will be learning are she, he ,of, go. At home: Please look for objects that have this weeks sounds in them.

In Maths the children will be learning to identify and understand circles and triangles. They will learn the correct names and be able to use the correct mathematical language of sides, corners, curved, round, circle and triangle.

Encourage your child to look for shapes in their environment for example a clock, signs, traffic lights etc

We will be continuing with our topic Birthdays. This week we will still be thinking about Advent; a time for getting ready. We will introduce the Advent Wreath to the children and talk about its special features. They will learn it is round because it represents Jesus love being continuous. They will also be told about the meaning behind the five candles.

At Home: Encourage your child to tell you the colours of the five candles and what they represent.



In Literacy we will continue with our text 'We're Going to find the Monster.' The children will continue to rehearse the text as speaking is so important in order to develop good writers. This week we will be focussing on the characters. We will then write our own version of the story using new characters and adjectives.



The children will be revisiting all the new sounds they have been learning this half term! They will be reading a range of different words containing these. The new tricky words we will be learning are, we, me, be.

Practise reading some simple words using the sounds we have already learnt, for example, cat, can, van, pink, dog etc



In Maths, the children will be finding out about four and five. They will use their super subitising skills to recognise these quantities and explain how they know, for example 'that is four because it has a group of 2 and a group of 2.

## At Home:

Play games with your child involving a dice. Encourage them not to count the spots but to recognise the patterns they see.

This week we will be combining RE and Literacy together. We will be thinking about the Christmas Story. The children will spend the week hearing the story, re-telling it, ordering it and eventually writing a small part of it. We are also busy practising for our nativity play.

At Home: Please look for the Advent Wreath in church this week and talk about what you can see.

In Maths, the children will be continuing to focus on the numbers four and five. This week they will be thinking about one more and one less with these numbers. They will know where these numbers come on a number line and what happens when we add one more or take away one.

## At Home:

Talk with your child about numbers 1 - 5. Can they say how they know where the number comes, for example, I know 5 is one more than 4.'


