Dear parents/carers,

The children have had a busy week in Nursery. They have had fun choosing their learning with their friends.

Let's take a glimpse into what the children will be exploring and accomplishing in Religious Education, Communication, Language and Literacy, Phonics, and Maths next week.

Religious Education

We are continuing our topic of 'Gathering'. The children have been thinking about times that they gather together, in Nursery, at home and at Church. We will be thinking about what we do at Church when we gather together for mass or a special occasion like a baptism.

<u>Home Learning:</u> When you are together at home maybe eating together, watching television together or playing together talk about how you have gathered together as a family to do this.

Our initial sound will be 'g'. The children will be learning to say the sound and looking at objects and pictures that start with the sound 'g' e.g: grapes, glue and goat. We will be playing 'what's in the box?' to support this.

Home Learning:

Have a look at home or when you are out and about to see if you can find things that begin with 'g'. Maybe you can play 'I spy with my little eye, something beginning with 'g'. '

Communication, Language and Literacy

We have started our traditional tales topic. The children will be exposed to a number of traditional tales. We will be identifying the characters and talk about where the story is set. By Easter the children will be able recite at least three traditional tales. Our first story is Goldilocks and the Three Bears.

Maths

We are now looking at the 5. This week the children will be adding one more to number 4 to make 5. We will do this using objects and pictures in Nursery both inside and out in the garden to find a set of 5 objects.

<u>Home Learning:</u> To support your child's learning you could ask your child to count 5 objects such as toys or other objects you have had home or see out and about such as cars.
