Religious Education	Maths	
We will continue our topic 'Holidays/Holy days'. We will learn about the events of the day Jesus ascended into Heaven, and how Jesus appeared to his disciples and made a promise to send His Holy Spirit to them	Over the next three weeks we will be learning about multiplication and division. The children will learn how to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.	
<b>Home learning:</b> Discuss with your child what it feels like when somebody who is close to your family is leaving for a while. How does it make you feel?	<b>Home Learning</b> : Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's with your child. Please also try to show them the multiplication facts that go with these numbers e.g. 1x2=2, 2x2=4, 3x2=6, 4x2=8, 5x2=10.	
English	<u>Phonics</u>	
<b>English</b> Next week we will be creating our own story maps for the story of Little Red Riding Hood. At the end of the week we will begin write the story of Little Red Riding Hood in our own words.	Phonics This half term the children are recapping sounds in order to consolidate their knowledge preparation for the phonics screening check in June. They are reading 'alien' words daily in their phonics sessions as part of this preparation.	

**Please** ensure you are reading daily with your child at home, this is very important and can have a huge impact on the development of your child's reading. The reading books are matched to the children's current phonic knowledge and this allows them to apply
