Communication, Language and Literacy



Next week we will be ordering the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' using props to retell the story. The children will continue observing the growth of the caterpillars in the classroom as the insects begin making their cocoons.

We will be writing sentences about what happens at each stage of the lifecycle of butterflies and making lifecycle information diagrams.



At Home:

For example: Is the fruit **in** your bowl or **on** your bowl? Do you sit **on** the chair or **at** the chair?

Maths Development



Next week we will continue to learn how to double numbers. We will be using dice to double numbers from 1-10. We will be sequencing the days of the week from The Very Hungry Caterpillar and writing missing numbers on 1-20 number lines.

For example: 11, 12, ?, 14, 15. ?, ?, 18, 19, 20.

At Home:

Please practice counting forwards and backward to 20. Ask your child to pick a number to 20 and then ask them what number is one more and what number is one less.

For example: 12 one more than 12 is 13 and one less than 12 is 11.
