Maths Development



The children will continue to learn about capacity next week using water and sand. They will use vocabulary such as: 'half- full', 'full', 'empty'. They will be filling up buckets and containers and comparing the amounts. We will also be asking the children to solve simple problems in relation to capacity.

For Example: How many yoghurt pots do you think it will take to fill up a big jug?



<u>At home:</u>

Ask your child to fill come containers with water/ liquid, either in the bath or in a sink. Can they fill a container so it is full or half -full? Which one has more/ less?
