Communication, Language and Literacy

Maths Development



The children have really grasped the concept of tally charts and have been busy asking their friends their favourite colours, animals, chocolate bars etc. Next week we will be showing the children how to put the information from a tally chart into a pictogram (graph). We will then use this information to answer simple questions like which is the most popular /least popular. How many children like blue and red?

At home: Ask your child to come up with their own survey questions to ask the family. Can they find a way to record the answers?
