Maths Development



Next week we will be revisiting subtraction. The children will be rolling a dice to subtract a certain number from 20.

e.g I have 14, then I roll a dice and it shows 3 so 14 take away 3 equals 11.

The children will be completing lots of games that will help reinforce the concept of subtraction.

At home: Ask your child to take away 2 or 3 objects from a set and see how many they have left.
